HOW TO HOST A CLEANUP

SELECT AN APPROPRIATE SITE, DATE, AND TIME

- Choose a public location: a park, a river, or a similar community site that is ideally accessible by public transportation or bicycle.
- TIP: Make sure to check and see if you need any necessary local permissions. Select a convenient date for your cleanup.
- Select a time: Depending on where you are, choose a time that allows for plenty of daylight and comfortable temperatures for volunteers.
- TIP: Most cleanups start between 9:00am & 11:00am.





GATHER VOLUNTEERS

- Appoint site captains who will manage the event and designate roles to assure the cleanup goes smoothly (See Cleanup Checklist Below). Invite your UPS colleagues to help plan your cleanup!
- Register your cleanup on <u>UPS Community Connections</u> (US/ LATAM/Europe/ISMEA/APAC) or <u>N2N</u> (Germany/Austria).
- TIP: If you want volunteers outside of UPS to join, register your cleanup on the REGISTER YOUR PUBLIC CLEANUP at earthday.org/ups
- Advertise your cleanup to UPS colleagues via <u>UPS</u>
 <u>Community Connections</u> or <u>N2N</u>, family, friends, and community members.

GET SUPPLIES & ARRANGE FOR DISPOSAL

- Gather supplies. Important Items To Have: Trash Bags or Buckets, Trash Grabbers, First Aid Kit, Gloves, Hand Sanitizer, Water & Snacks.
- Coordinate with local waste management through a short phone call to ensure everything is being disposed of in accordance with rules and regulations.
- Be sure that contributors get credit for their donations in cleanup promotions.



DAY OF AND AFTER YOUR CLEANUP



- Closer to the date, check the weather to dress appropriately.
- Send a reminder the night before and the day of the cleanup to all participants.
- As a leader, arrive to the event early to set up before volunteers arrive and welcome them.
- Invite local media outlets to cover the event if you have a large event.
- Share your cleanup results on www.earthday.org/ups
- Log your hours in <u>UPS Community Connections</u> or <u>N2N</u>
