#### **Forest Connections**

Subject: Content/Social Sciences

Grade Level: Elementary School (K-3rd)

Time: 30 minutes

Objective: Students will make connections from the book to their own lives through the

connection of trees, animals, and people.

# Introduction (10 minutes):

Read The Great Kapok Tree to your students

After reading, ask the following questions:

How are the animals and plants connected in the rainforest?

- Why is it important to protect the rainforest?
- What can we do to help protect rainforests?

# Activity: Map it Out (15 minutes):

Students will make an Ecosystem Web of 3-5 things (animals, plants, people) and how they are connected to each other. Students will write the word and give a 2-3 sentence description

Example: Pine Tree -> pine cones -> squirrels

### **Conclusion (5 minutes):**

Students will understand that trees are an important part of the ecosystem that we live in. Everything is connected and we need to take care of the environment.
