# HOW TO HOST A CLEANUP SELECT AN APPROPRIATE SITE, DATE, AND TIME

Choose a public location: a park, a river, or a similar community site that is ideally accessible by public

TIP: Make sure to check and see if you need any necessary local permissions. Select a convenient date for your cleanup.

Select a time: Depending on where you are, choose a time that allows for plenty of daylight and comfortable temperatures for volunteers.

TIP: Most cleanups start between 9:00am & 11:00am.







- Appoint site captains to manage the event and assign roles to ensure the cleanup runs smoothly. (See Cleanup Checklist below)
- Invite your UPS colleagues to help plan your cleanup!

- TIP: If you want volunteers outside of UPS to join, register your event at: REGISTER YOUR PUBLIC CLEANUP

#### **GET SUPPLIES & ARRANGE FOR DISPOSAL**

- Gather supplies. Important Items To Have: Trash Bags or Buckets, Trash Grabbers, First Aid Kit, Gloves, Hand Sanitizer, Water & Snacks.
- Coordinate with local waste management through a short phone call to ensure everything is being disposed of in accordance with rules and regulations.
- Be sure that contributors get credit for their donations in cleanup promotions.



## DAY OF AND AFTER YOUR CLEANUP



- Closer to the date, check the weather to dress appropriately.
- Send a reminder the night before and the day of the cleanup to all participants.
- As a leader, arrive early to set up before volunteers arrive and to welcome them.
- Invite local media outlets to cover the event if you're hosting a large cleanup.
- Share your cleanup results at www.earthday.org/ups.
